<b>Branscombe Vale</b>	A Pint of Two Halves 4%	Brewed in the modern English IPA style.
	Summa That 5%	Strong golden ale. Clean & easy drinking.
<b>Clearwater</b>	Proper Ansome 4.2%	Malty flavoured and dark coloured bitter ale for the more discerning drinker
	Devon Darter 4.5%	A fruity copper ale with a nutty light bitterness and an aroma reminiscent of grapes
<b>Coastal</b>	Relentless Sea 4%	Golden & hoppy with a citrus nose.
	Golden Sands 5.8%	Full-flavoured strong golden ale. Silver medal winner at SIBA Southwest 2008
<b>Cotleigh</b>	Tawny Owl 3.8%	A subtle hop palate blending with the sweetness of the malt, to give a balanced bitter
	Honey Buzzard 4.5%	Copper coloured & infused with local honey. A smooth creamy & chocolate palate with subtle bitter sweet finish
<b>Countrylife</b>	Golden Pig 4.7%	Full-bodied strong bitter
	Black Boar 5%	Smooth & smokey – a dark ruby red porter, very easy drinking dark beer
<b>Dartmoor Brewery</b>	Dartmoor IPA 4%	Hoppy-nosed session beer
	Jail Ale 4.8%	Full-flavoured & hoppy

<b>Devon Earth</b>	Earth of Devon 4.7%	A new hoppy beer for the summer made with Cascade hops.
<b>Exe Valley</b>	Dob's Best Bitter 4.1%	Smooth, well hopped, fruit aroma, bitter throughout
	Beerwolf 4.5%	A darker mid strength premium bitter
<b>Exeter</b>	Avocet Ale 3.9%	Devon's only organic real ale. Distinctively-flavoured with a refreshing citrus taste.
	Ferryman 4.2%	Copper coloured Premium ale. Well balanced flavour with generous handfuls of Goldings hops.
	Darkness 4.8%	Dark mysterious & rarely seen. This full bodied beer is not for the faint hearted!
<b>Gidley's</b>	Spinney 4.1%	Deep ruby red ale, easy to drink with good overtones of malt and a hoppy finish.
	Meadow 4.5%	Golden amber beer with a fresh hoppy aroma & a clean feel on the palate, a very quaffable beer.
<b>Hunters</b>	Denbury Dreamer 4.1%	Lovely malt flavours with a light hop floral finish
	Pheasant Plucker 4.3%	Rounded yet surprisingly delicate dark strong ale, a bitter sweet finish with delicate caramel taste.
<b>Jolly Boat</b>	Mainbrace 4.2%	Amber ale with malt & hops on the nose & a well balanced malt & bitter finish
	Hart of Oak 4.4%	A rich & velvety mellow brown bitter
<b>Keltek</b>	Golden Lance 4%	Pale & fruity with a citrus bias. CAMRA Cornish Champion Ale 2003.
	Keltek King 4.8%	Exceptionally well balanced & long lasting on the palate – a national & international champion bitter
<b>Lizard</b>	Frenchmans Creek 4.6%	Cornish pale ale with plenty of hops for a floral aroma
	An Gof 5.2%	Brewed with wood smoked malt and traditional hops to commemorate a local hero
<b>O'Hanlons</b>	Goldblade 4%	A finely balanced Wheat Beer of exceptional flavour,
	Yellow Hammer 4.2%	Dry hopping at the final stage gives our most popular beer a truly unique & refreshing feel
<b>Otter</b>	Otter Bright 4.3%	A very refreshing beer with a fruity taste. The aftertaste is sweet with a subtle bitterness
	Otter Ale 4.5%	Delivers malt and fruit notes, with a combination of fruit and some bitterness to finish
<b>Palmers</b>	Dorset Gold 4.5%	Refreshing golden premium ale, fruity & lightly hopped

<b>Red Rock</b>	Lighthouse 3.9%	Runner up bitter at South Devon CAMRA festival 09. Dry finish with a floral hop nose & citrus palate.
	Red Rock 4.2%	Our traditional well-balanced best bitter.
	Breakwater 4.6%	Blend of 3 types of malt & 3 of hops give a mouth filling flavour of roasted malt balanced with a heavy hop finish.
<b>Sharps</b>	Doom Bar 4%	A complex blend of dried fruit, light roasted malty notes & subtle bitterness
	Sharps Own 4.4%	Rich roasted with malty notes & a sweet malty finish - packed with flavour

<b>Skinnners</b>	Betty Stogs 4%	Classic pale amber mid strength bitter with distinct hoppy overtones. Beautifully balanced quaffing ale. Contains Cornish malted barley and wheat.
	Cornish Knockers 4.5%	A strong, refreshing, clean tasting golden ale, with flowery & fruity hops in the mouth & malt undertones.
<b>South Hams</b>	Devon Pride 3.8%	Rich in flavour, this beer defies it's ABV with a surprising amount of body. A malty palate with hints of fruit.
	Eddystone 4.8%	A not so bitter beer with a distinctly fruity aroma, and very fruity palette. An IPA of real taste!
<b>St Austell</b>	Dartmoor Best Bitter 3.9%	A fine, easy drinking session ale with a touch of bitterness, complemented by a smooth malty finish.
	Tribute 4.2%	Supreme Champion Ale of Cornwall as voted by CAMRA, with a rich aroma of biscuity malt & tart citrus fruit.
	Proper Job 4.5%	An authentic IPA, powerfully hopped and exploding with citrus grapefruit flavours.
<b>Teignworthy</b>	Neap Tide 3.8%	A good tasty, fruity bitter.
	Beachcomber 4.5%	A bright golden, full bodied, citrus tasting ale, with a smooth finish & bags of flavour!
	Martha's Mild 5.3%	Sweet, dark, ruby red mild, with a biscuit background.
<b>Yeovil Ales</b>	Stargazer 4%	Dark copper speciality bitter with a late hopping floral bouquet, it is rich & hoppy yet sweet & luscious!
	British Summer Time 4.5%	A zesty pale ale with rounded bitterness and crisp pleasant lemon & grapefruit aromas
	Posh IPA 5.4%	Pale with body and mouth feel it's strength is balanced by a truly fruity late-hopped finish. Gold Award winner for strong ales at the 2010 SIBA SW Beer Festival
